


What is Story Structure?

- Cumulative: There Was an Old Dragon Who Swallowed a Knight, The House in the Night
- Mirror: Boy + Bot, A Sick Day for Amos McGee
- Parallel: The Dog Who Belonged to No One, Blueberries for Sal
- **Reversal**: Children Make Terrible Pets, Little Pea
- Meta: I Thought This Was a Bear Book, Warning: Do Not Open This Book!
- **How To**: So You Want to Be a Rock Star, How to Babysit a Grandpa/Grandma
- Fractured Fairy Tales: The Three Ninja Pigs, Little Red Gliding Hood

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
